EMBRACING CHANGES TO SERVE OTHERS

Over the past several months, daily living as we were accustomed has changed. The COVID pandemic situation has required us to adjust to various restrictions, delays, cancellations and unexpected changes. Mobile Meals delivery schedules, volunteer involvement and fundraisers have experienced change. A change that has not occurred at Mobile Meals is ensuring our meal recipients are fed. We have continued delivering meals in the midst of the enormous changes around us.

Our recipients needed assistance before COVID19 and they still need our assistance. Our goal is to safely provide nutritious meals to homebound seniors and to protect our volunteers who deliver the meals.

In March 2020, Mobile Meals adhered to guidelines set forth by the state and CDC to ensure the safety of all recipients, volunteers and staff. New practices were implemented and the necessary changes were put into action;

- Social distancing was immediately encouraged.
- Our meal delivery schedule was changed to delivering meals every other day as we adjusted to having fewer volunteers. Each delivery day our recipients receive a hot and a frozen meal.
- The process for volunteers picking up meals at our facility was changed to a Drive-thru.
- Mask, gloves and sanitizer are provided to volunteers as they pick up meals at the Drive-thru.
- Staff members check their temperature upon arrival to work each morning, wash their hands often, wear masks, practice social distancing and wear gloves as needed.
- Administrative staff began assisting with filling food trays in place of the Food Production Volunteers.
- Our fundraisers have either been postponed or cancelled leaving a gap in our annual budget.
- Communications through social media, phone calls, and email became a
 vital source to stay engaged with our community and supporters as we
 adjust to the necessary changes.

Mobile Meals continues to serve our 1200 meals recipients with the same passion as we did before any changes due to a pandemic. We are thankful for the Lord's blessings and assurance that He never changes and we can depend on Him.

GRATITUDE TO SPECIAL VOLUNTEERS

Due to the stay at home order issued early on and the risk factors involved for seniors, many of our faithful volunteers could not deliver. The Lord provided in an incredible way as several churches asked how they could help. NewSpring Church, Anderson Mill Baptist Church and The Jesus Christ Our Risen Savior Knights of Columbus, amongst many individuals came to help with meal deliveries. We owe each of those represented a debt of gratitude! We could not fulfill our meal delivery efforts without assistance of our community.



MEMORIES OF CAMP CROFT COURTS AND ROY AND JIBBA POWELL HOW THEIR LIVES CONTINUE TO BLESS OTHERS!

Sitting with Roy and Jibba Powell in the reception area for Mobile Meals in the 90's, they shared a very memorable story with me. Even though very ill with lung cancer, Roy insisted on continuing to deliver "their" route each week. This very day he had received a radiation treatment and the two of them (always) came to Mobile Meals to "sit awhile until I get my legs back under me," Roy would say. After 30 minutes or so they would faithfully deliver their route with food and love to Camp Croft Courts.

Camp Croft Courts was very special to them. Back in the 40's, Roy spent several years on active duty in World War II in the Aleutian Islands, which ended with an Allied victory over the occupying Japanese Army, followed by duty in Alaska and finally in Washington D.C.

Camp Croft Courts was a new project built for returning Spartanburg military and their families. The Powells moved into those apartments in late 1945 and lived there for 5 years. Many of you may know

Perrin Powell (former principal of McCracken Junior High), one of the Powells' 3 children, was born there.

In 1950 they moved to Boyd Street. They faithfully delivered and contributed to Mobile Meals from 1977 (the year Mobile Meals began) until within weeks of Roy's death in late 1997.

Roy and Jibba generously set up the Roy S. and Elizabeth P. Powell Mobile Meals Trust Fund with the Spartanburg County Foundation which annually provides a very generous gift to feed those in need, many of which are in Camp Croft Courts.

Their cycle of loving others and taking care of those in need will continue forever from their trust!

Updates

FUNDRAISERS IMPACTED BY COVID IN 2020 CANCELLATIONS AND CHANGES

Mobile Meals and other organizations coordinates many fundraisers throughout the year to support our 1.8 million dollar budget to feed Spartanburg's frail and homebound. We are not a government agency and depend on the donations to meet our budget. The COVID pandemic restrictions made the logistics for numerous events a challenge and unfortunately changes were necessary. The community has been incredibly understanding and we sincerely appreciate the continued support as we made changes.



THE BEN WRIGHT INTERNATIONAL CHALLENGE CUP (ICC) fundraiser is a substantial part of Mobile Meals annual budget grossing \$350,000 to \$400,000 each year. This year the ICC would celebrate the 25th Anniversary since its inception. The event is usually held in May though it was rescheduled for September 11th with hopes that COVID would be behind us by that time. Unfortunately, the event had to be canceled for 2020. The ICC Committee believed holding the ICC tournament in 2020 would significantly compromise the historical integrity of this great event. The two key factors that lead to this decision: The host clubs understandable social distancing logistical restrictions due to COVID and most importantly the well-being of our expected 224 golfers.



DINE AROUND is the annual event involving many local restaurants throughout Spartanburg County. This event is considered a win-win for both the restaurants and Mobile Meals. Keenly aware that our restaurants were among those hardest hit businesses, we decided to cancel out Dine-Around for October 2020 and will forward to October 2021. We pray our city and county and world will have rebounded and we can once again reach out to local restaurants and ask to join hands with us in 2021.



In April 2020 the **HUB CITY HOG FEST**, a popular community event held downtown Spartanburg benefiting Mobile Meals was cancelled. The new date will be announced at a later time. This annual event has previously provided up to \$75,000 to help feed our seniors. The barbeque competition is recognized as a South Carolina Barbeque Association-sanctioned BBQ Cook-Off. The participants include competitors from numerous states.



In March 2020 our second largest event, the **LAND CRUISE** was scheduled to set sail to Scotland sponsored by JM Smith Foundation and WSPA. The band, Back 9 and emcee Gordon Dill, WSPA news anchor and David Taylor auctioneer were all set to make a great event. Spartan Photo was ready to take cruise photos. The day before the event took place, Mobile Meals board of Directors, in good faith made the decision to protect the 600 guests and volunteers by postponing the event until March 12, 2021. This event generally grosses \$250,000 annually. Join us in March 2021 as we set sail to Scotland!
