GLDI Application Process: Frequently Asked Questions

- How to I apply to be in GLDI?
 - *After you read the Frequently Asked Questions, there is a link at the bottom of the page. That link will take you to a website called Goapply where you'll click "sign up" to start the process.*
- I clicked the link at the bottom, and it takes me to a plain page. Am I in the right place?
 - **Yes. The website has Goapply in the top left corner. If you haven't created a user account, click "Sign Up." If you've already created an account, and are back to finish the application, simply sign in with the password you created.**
- I signed in, but I'm confused about which option to choose. What's the correct application?
 - *We use this system for all The Spartanburg County Foundation's grants and applications, so don't be alarmed if you see more than the GLDI application. There is an Application Name called "Grassroots Leadership Development Institute 2022 Application." Click Apply (to the left of the Application Name) to begin the application.*
- I see the application, but it's listed under "Funding Opportunities." Are you SURE I'm in the right place?
 - *Yes, we're sure. It's a quirk of the system. Click apply and get started!*
- I've started the application but need to finish it later. Will I lose my work if I leave?
 - *You will not lose your work IF you save everything. Save often and you can come back to it as many times as you need to.*
- Do I have to upload my letters of recommendation in this system?
 - *It's simpler for you and us if you use the system to upload your letters of recommendation. However, if you're having technical issues with that piece, please email both letters (at the same time) to Evan McLeod at emcleod@spcf.org. **If you're emailing the letters, they are still due by the application deadline.***
- When is the application due?
 - *The application is due **Friday, January 14, 2022**. We encourage everyone to start on it early. The holidays are quickly approaching, and we don't want you to run out of time!*
- I've read the FAQ multiple times and still can't access the system. What now?
