

GLDI Application Process: Frequently Asked Questions

- How do I apply to be in GLDI?
 - After you read the Frequently Asked Questions, there is a link at the bottom of the page. That link
 will take you to a website called GOapply where you'll click "register a new account" to start the
 process. You will register as an individual.
 - If you think you already have an account, but aren't sure, reach out to Evan Petty at <u>epetty@spcf.org</u>
- I've created an account, but how do I access the application?
 - Oclick "opportunities" at the top of the page. The opportunity name is 2024 Grassroots Leadership Development Institute. Click "view" to begin.
- I've started the application but need to finish it later. Will I lose my work if I leave?
 - You will not lose your work but be sure to save the application by clicking the "SAVE DRAFT" button at the bottom of the screen.
 - To access your saved application, click "submissions" at the top of the screen and you'll see the saved application under the "In Progress" tab.
- Do I have to upload my letters of recommendation in this system?
 - We ask that you please use the system to attach your letters of recommendation. You may email them to Evan Petty at epetty@spcf.org only if you're having technical issues. If you're emailing the letters, they are still due by the application deadline.
- When is the application due?
 - o The application is due Thursday, December 7, 2023.
- How can I be certain that you received my application?
 - You can click on "Submissions" and find your completed application under the "submitted" tab. You will also receive email confirmation that the application was received.
