Spartanburg County Foundation and Spartanburg Academic Movement are partnering to facilitate *Catalytic Grantmaking* to deepen the capacity of place-based nonprofits serving Spartanburg County. A **place-based partner** is a network of people or organizations in the same geographic area who work together to change systems, improve community outcomes, and achieve shared goals.

The *Catalytic Grantmaking* opportunity aims to support the refining of place-based nonprofit operational processes. Grants of up to \$20,000 will be awarded to **placed-based 501(c)3 organizations** to strengthen their ability in one or more of the following areas:

- Talent Recruitment, Retention, and Development
- Financial Management and Development
- Marketing, Communications, and Fundraising

Applicant Information

Applicant information includes organization name, employer identification number (EIN), physical address, phone number, email address, website, and mission statement.

Narrative
